Bulb Planting ideas-

- Agreed that bed north of Browning Estate should be priority for Play Ranger planting session [note needs digging over first).
- Bluebells also ready for planting, also with Play Ranger session
- Other areas for planting on work day for remaining bulbs include Rodney Road/Orb street entrance and by East St market under Plane Trees

Planting by Crown Terrace-

- Attendees agreed that list of plants provided by Southwark was excellent and fine to go ahead

ACTION: Luke to find out what date/time they will be planted, need to avoid damaging hollyhocks and bulbs on perimeter
